We say a fond farewell to our 6th class pupils who leave Kildalkey N.S. to embark on the next chapter

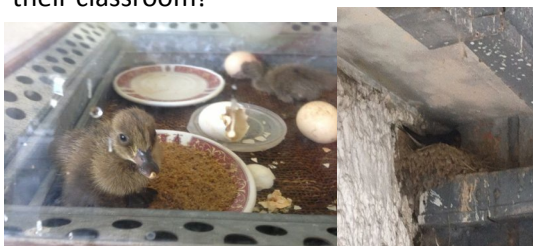
